






Grain: World Markets and Trade

Larger Global Carry-in Stocks More Than Offset Forecast Lower Production



The world's grain stocks situation is much improved for 2009/10, with an 85 MMT buildup. In 2008/09, tight supplies and strong demand have supported high global wheat, corn, and rice prices. Rising global grain stocks will provide a buffer against smaller grain crops as consumption continues to grow. While production in 2009 is forecast down from the previous year, it remains larger than projected consumption. Grain ending stocks for 2009/10 are forecast to grow only 8 MMT, down from 80 MMT the previous year.

Wheat is expected to account for almost 60 percent of the growth in global beginning stocks, driven primarily by the United States and the EU-27, which hold stocks that are mostly available to the world market. The buildup in coarse grain beginning stocks, which account for 30 percent of the growth in global grain stocks, is mostly attributed to higher corn stocks in China, and barley stocks in the EU. While U.S. corn beginning stocks are a significant part of global coarse grain stocks, there is a decline expected in 2009/10. Global rice stocks are forecast to expand for the third consecutive year.

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The Foreign Agricultural Service (FAS) updates its production, supply and distribution database for cotton, oilseeds, and grains at 9 a.m. on the day the World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates (WASDE) report is released. It is available on the FAS website (<http://www.fas.usda.gov/psdonline/>). This circular is released at 10:00 a.m. on the same day, together with its downloadable data set.

Circular Modifications:

The following changes are incorporated into this May 2009 Circular:

- For rice, the local marketing year definition was changed for all countries in Africa to create more consistency and to be more in line with local harvests. Countries located predominately above the equator now have a marketing year running from October through September, while countries south of the equator now run from May through April. The series was modified starting with 2005/2006.

The rice series for Ecuador was revised back to MY 1991/1992 based on updated production data. The changes had little impact on trade, however.

- There were historical revisions to several countries and commodities.



WHEAT: WORLD MARKETS AND TRADE


Global Wheat Production Surpasses Consumption for Second Straight Year



Global wheat production is projected to reach 658 million tons, down 25 million tons from last year's record. Global consumption is projected to expand to 643 million tons up nearly 7 million tons. Last year's consumption growth came mainly from greater use in animal feeds, however, feed use is expected to decline this year, but it is still large compared to historical levels. For the second straight year, global stocks are expected to climb. The large stock carry-in will more than offset the forecast production decline, which should continue to pressure prices. Global trade is expected to decline 10 million tons from last years' record to 121.8 million tons as the Middle East, North Africa and South Asian domestic production are expected to recover from last year's low level.

crop, thus limiting its exportable surplus to the lowest level in 21 years.

The large carry-in for the U.S. will only partially offset reduced production. Ending stocks are projected to decrease nearly 1 million tons. In 2008/09, the United States was able to supply early-season exports due to short supplies throughout major importing countries. However, with beginning stocks in most countries recovering, this scenario is unlikely to repeat itself in 2009/10. Consequently, exports are forecast 2.5 million tons lower.


Australian exports are forecast to increase slightly to 14.5 million tons on a continued recovery in production from past drought-reduced crops. However, that supply will not be available for another 6 months when the new crop is harvested.

Selected Exporters


A key factor for the world wheat market is the large carry-in stocks held by most major exporters, **Argentina** notwithstanding. **Australia, Canada, the EU, Russia, Kazakhstan, Ukraine** and the **United States**, will all begin the year with larger stocks, a situation which is drastically changed from just one year ago.

Argentina, on the other hand, is expected to have another short

Percent




Global Market Share of the EU and the Black Sea Percent



Black Sea country's exports continue to expand at the expense of the EU. While exports are expected to decline from last year, the **Black Sea** countries are still expected to maintain its high level of exports.

Competition for soft wheat in the **Mediterranean** and the **Middle East** markets is expected to intensify further this year as crops in this region are expected to recover.


Middle East and North Africa Production and Imports



Selected Importers

North African and **Middle Eastern** imports are expected to decline by 6 million tons, driven by a recovery from last year's drought-impacted crops, reducing the need for imports.

Imports in **South Asia** are expected to drop about 40 percent or 4 million tons as larger crops in countries like **Pakistan**, and **Afghanistan**, are all expected to import much less wheat due to the availability of domestic supplies.



PRICES:

Domestic: All classes of wheat saw dramatic declines from the extraordinary price surges in the spring of 2008, and the U.S. season-average-price forecast for 2009/10 is down significantly from last year's record.

TRADE CHANGES IN 2008/2009

Selected Exporters:

- **Canada** is down 1.0 million tons to 16.5 million on the continued slow pace of shipments and intensified competition from the Black Sea and the EU.
- **EU** is up 1.0 million tons to 22.0 million on continued sales as reflected by the pace of export licenses.
- **Kazakhstan** is down 700,000 tons to 4.5 million as logistical and transportation constraints limit exports.
- **Russia** is up 500,000 tons to 17.0 million on a continued strong export pace.
- **Ukraine** is raised 1.0 million tons to a record 12.0 million because of continued strong demand for feed-quality wheat.

-
- **United States** is up 500,000 tons to 27.0 million on stronger global demand.

Selected Importers:

- **Egypt** is up 300,000 tons to 8.5 million, a record, as imports, -especially from Russia- continue to be strong.
- **Iraq** is down 300,000 tons to 3.4 million on the slowing pace of imports.
- **South Korea** is cut 600,000 tons to 3.2 million due to the slow pace of imports, particularly of feed-quality wheat.
- **Pakistan** is up 400,000 tons to 3.2 million on larger Russian purchases.
- **Philippines** is boosted 400,000 tons to 3.0 million due to additional purchases of feed-quality wheat from Ukraine.
- **Saudi Arabia** is raised 350,000 tons to 1.1 million as the government builds stocks while it phases out domestic production.
- **Turkey** is up 500,000 tons to 3.0 million based on the strong pace of imports, particularly from Russia.



RICE: WORLD MARKETS AND TRADE

Global Rice Production Surpasses Consumption Again; Major Exporters Continue to Build Stocks



Global production is forecast to reach a record for the third year in a row because governments of both importing and exporting countries are providing incentives to farmers to plant more rice. Some major importing countries such as Indonesia and Bangladesh are pursuing ways to boost production through subsidizing input costs and/or raising procurement prices. Meanwhile, in Thailand, high government prices are also an incentive to expand production.

The build-up in stocks among major exporters is mainly attributed to India where stocks jumped 50 percent since 2007 as a result of export restrictions. India is expected to expand exports sometime after this month's national elections.

With record global production, large carry-in stocks, and reductions in export restrictions, global prices are expected to soften. The current price of Thailand's 100B is about \$550 per ton, half the price this time last year.

SELECTED TRADE CHANGES FOR 2009 (AND BACK, WHERE NOTED)

- **Bangladesh's** imports are down 300,000 tons to 700,000 on large domestic supplies caused by record production.
- **Egypt's** exports are slashed by 500,000 tons to 300,000 on continued export restrictions.
- **Guinea's** imports are cut by 100,000 tons to 150,000 for both 2009 and 2008 on the pace to date for 2009 and final data for 2008.
- **Indonesia's** imports are slashed 450,000 tons to 350,000 because record production has reduced the need for imports.
- **Iran's** imports are raised 300,000 tons to 1.7 million on below normal production. In addition, new data through 2008 led to the following upward revisions in trade:

- **Mozambique's** imports are bumped 100,000 tons to 350,000 based on the current import pace.
- **Nigeria's** imports are dropped 100,000 tons to 1.6 million because of the large carry-in stocks built by traders in 2008 when the government suspended all duties on rice imports.
- **North Korea's** imports are cut 250,000 tons to 50,000 as there is no indication South Korea will resume exports in the near future.
- **Philippines'** imports are reduced 200,000 tons to 1.8 million based on record production, large stocks, and purchases to date.




COARSE GRAINS: WORLD MARKETS AND TRADE





World **coarse grain** production in 2009 is forecast nearly 17 million tons below last year's record. With global consumption expanding by 18.6 million tons, ending stocks are forecast to drop 12 million tons or 6 percent. World coarse grain trade is expected up slightly at 81 million tons.

Global **corn** production is forecast at 785 million tons, nearly unchanged from last year. Consumption is projected to climb 18 million tons to a record of nearly 797 million tons.

Corn used for ethanol in the **United States** is expected to grow by almost 9 million tons, or 10 percent from last year, to a record high. Feed use is forecast to ease fractionally by 3 million tons.

World corn trade is expected to be up from last year, but still be in line with the long-term trend. U.S. exports and market share are forecast slightly up because of less competition from feed wheat and expanded global demand. **Ukrainian** exports are down 2 million tons on less production and indications of expanding domestic feed use. **Mexican** and **Korean** imports are forecast up 500,000 tons each due to a return to normal buying



patterns.


World **barley** trade is expected to decline on higher production in some major importing countries. **Russian**, **Ukrainian**, and **EU** exports are forecast lower than last year on robust crops and reduced import demand in **North Africa** and the **Middle East**. In particular, **Iranian** imports are expected to fall as a result of higher production and better pasture.

Global **sorghum** trade is forecast at over 5.6 million tons, up 5 percent. Sorghum imports for the **EU** and **Chile** are forecast higher in 2009/10. **Mexican** imports are forecast at 2.2 million tons, slightly down year-to-year and continuing a downward trend, while **Japanese** imports are forecast unchanged from the current year's forecast at 1.4 million tons.

Global **oats** trade is forecast to remain flat with large carry-in stocks in major producing countries. **Canadian** exports to the **United States** are forecast unchanged year-to-year as a result.

PRICES:

Domestic: U.S. corn export prices averaged \$172 per ton in April, up \$4 from March, but down \$79 compared to April 2008. Uncertainty over U.S. planting progress (expectations of tightened supplies) and the brisk pace of exports support higher prices. Like corn, sorghum prices averaged \$168 per ton in April, up \$5 from March, but down \$86 compared to the same time last year.



HIGHLIGHTS FOR 2008/09

Selected Exporters

- **U.S. corn** is boosted 500,000 tons to 44.5 million based on stronger demand from traditional markets such as South Korea and Taiwan.
- **Brazilian corn** is raised 500,000 tons to a record 10.0 million with ample supplies, stronger demand from Korea, and reduced competition from Argentina.
- **Chinese corn** is halved to 250,000 tons given its lack of price competitiveness.
- **EU barley** is slashed 500,000 tons to 3.5 million on the slow pace of export licenses and greater competition from Russia and Ukraine.
- **Russian barley** is lifted 200,000 tons to 2.4 million, a record, based on a more competitive position vis-à-vis the EU.

-
- **Ukrainian barley** is boosted 200,000 tons to 5.5 million, a record, due to the strong pace of exports to destinations in the Middle East.
 - **Australian sorghum** is raised 200,000 tons to 1.1 million on unexpectedly large shipments to Japan.
 - **Canadian oats** is lowered 300,000 tons to 1.9 million based on slower-than-expected exports to the United States.

Selected Importers

This month, corn importers are boosted over 1.5 million tons amid indications of a rebound in both trade and consumption.

- **U.S. corn** is raised 100,000 tons to 400,000 based on trade data with Canada.
- **Brazilian, Philippine, Syrian, and Uruguayan corn** are each raised 200,000 tons based on trade data. Strong imports from Brazil drive Philippines to a 9-year high, while Syria's estimate of 1.8 million tons is a record.
- **Egyptian corn** is lowered 300,000 tons to 3.7 million, the smallest in about 5 years, because of sluggish imports and diminished feed grain demand.
- **EU, Korean, and Taiwanese corn** are each boosted 500,000 tons based on sales and shipments data.
- **Moroccan corn** is cut 200,000 tons to 1.5 million based on trade data.
- **Saudi Arabian and Syrian barley** are raised 300,000 and 200,000 tons to 7.3 million and 1.2 million, respectively (the latter being a record), on continued strong imports from Russia and Ukraine.
- **Turkish barley** is lowered 200,000 tons due to expectations of a larger crop in 2009/10.
- **U.S. oats** is lowered 200,000 tons based on slower-than-expected imports from Canada.

OTHER NOTES

Local Marketing Years (LMY): LMY refers to the 12-month period following the main harvest, when the crop is marketed (i.e., consumed, traded, or stored). The year first listed begins a country's LMY for that commodity (2008/09 starts in 2008); except for summer grains in certain Southern Hemisphere countries and for rice in selected countries, where the second year begins the LMY (2008/09 starts in 2009). Stocks: Unless otherwise stated, stock data are based on an aggregate of differing local marketing years and should not be construed as representing world stock levels at a fixed point in time.

Consumption: World totals for consumption reflect total utilization, including food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste; as well as differences in local marketing year imports and local marketing year exports. Consumption statistics for regions and individual countries, however, reflect food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste only.

Trade: All PSD tables are balanced on the different local marketing years. All trade tables contain Trade Year (TY) data which puts all countries on a uniform, 12-month period for analytical comparisons: wheat is July/June; coarse grains, corn, barley, sorghum, oats, and rye are Oct/Sept; and rice is calendar year.

EU Consolidation: The trade figures starting from 1999/00 represent EU-27 and exclude all intra-trade. For the years 1960/61 through 1998/99, figures are the EU-15 and also exclude all intra-trade. EU-15 member states' data for grains are no longer maintained in the official USDA database. Data for the individual NMS-10, plus Bulgaria and Romania, exists only prior to 1999/00.

Statistics: (1) Wheat trade statistics include wheat, flour, and selected pasta products on a grain equivalent basis. (2) Rice trade statistics include rough, brown, milled, and broken on a milled

equivalent basis. (3) Coarse grains statistics include corn, barley, sorghum, oats, rye, millet, and mixed grains but exclude trade in barley malt, millet, and mixed grains.

Unaccounted: This term includes grain in transit, reporting discrepancies in some countries, and trade to countries outside the USDA database.
