




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Oilseeds: World Markets and Trade

U.S. Soybean Exports in 2003/04 Expected to Reach Lowest Level since 1998/99



Intense competition from South American soybeans is expected to push U.S. soybean exports lower in 2003/04 despite a 5-percent increase in production. Forecast soybean exports in 2003/04 are expected to reach 26.1 million tons. This is down 361,000 tons from 2002/03. Exports are forecast to account for 34 percent of production in 2003/04 compared to 37 percent in 2002/03. To find a lower value, you need to return to 1998/99 when exports totaled 21.9 million tons, accounting for 28 percent of production. Higher production, coupled with lower exports and limited growth prospects for soybean meal demand will result in higher ending stocks for 2003/04. However, with carry-in stocks at their lowest level since 1997, total soybean supplies will only expand by 2 percent in the coming year.

Situation and Outlook

The world oilseed export forecast for 2002/03 is up again this month with an increase of 262,000 tons to 75.0 million tons. This increase is largely due to a 90,000-ton increase in the world sunflowerseed export forecast and a 70,000-ton increase in the world soybean export forecast. Export forecasts have also increased for rapeseed, up 45,000 tons, palm kernel, up 30,000 tons and cottonseed, up 25,000 tons. Soybean exports for Argentina were lowered 400,000 tons this month, while U.S. soybean exports were increased 408,000 tons. Total world soybean imports were up 108,000 tons, with increases in imports by Japan, Indonesia, Mexico, Brazil and parts of the Middle East. However, imports by the European Union were down 500,000 tons from last month.

World soybean ending stocks estimates by USDA decreased this month. The ending stocks for 2002/03 are estimated at 30.96 million tons, down 118,000 tons from April. The decrease in ending stocks is mainly attributed to decreased stocks in the United States. The forecast for U.S. soybean ending stocks is down 273,000 tons this month to 3.7 million tons, while the forecast for both Brazil (11.7 million tons) and Argentina (10.7 million tons) is up this month by 100,000 tons each.

The world oilseed crush forecast declined to 269.3 million tons, down 178,000 tons from last month's estimate. Leading the decline in oilseed crush is China where rapeseed crush for 2002/03 was reduced 200,000 tons this month to 10 million tons. The lower crush this month for China was primarily due to a decrease in the forecast of China's rapeseed imports from 350,000 tons to 150,000 tons. Estimates of U.S. rapeseed crush are down 45,000 tons due to an increase of U.S. exports of rapeseed in the same amount.

The total oilseed meal export forecast for 2002/03 increased slightly this month to 63.4 million tons. Soybean meal exports increased 289,000 tons. This increase in exports was offset by decreases in export forecasts for sunflowerseed meal, peanut meal, and copra meal.

The vegetable oil production forecast for 2002/03 increased 177,000 tons this month to 92.9 million tons. Increased palm oil production, mainly for Malaysia, accounted for most of the increase this month. The vegetable oil export forecast for the European Union is down 45,000 tons from last month's figure, which is almost completely offset by a 41,000 ton increase in the vegetable oil export forecast for Argentina. The world soybean oil import forecast dropped to 10.06 million tons, as the consumption estimate dropped 80,000 tons to 30.5 million tons.

Notes on World Supply/Demand Tables

- 1) Trade, crush, consumption, and stocks data are aggregated using individual marketing years with the exception of Argentina and Brazil. These two countries are converted to an October-September basis. Marketing years for countries in the Northern Hemisphere begin in the first year shown. Those in the Southern Hemisphere begin in the second year.
- 2) World imports and exports will not balance. This is due to differences in marketing years and time lags between exportation and importation.
- 3) Stocks data are not estimated for all countries.
- 4) Price averages are dollars per bushel for soybeans, dollars per short ton for soybean meal and cents per pound for soybean oil.
